Drug overdose ranks as the leading cause of adult accidental deaths in the U.S. Commonly prescribed opioid pain relievers, like oxycodone and hydrocodone, are involved in more overdose deaths than any other opioid type.

In Rhode Island and Massachusetts laws were recently changed to allow individuals to get naloxone from the pharmacy directly without having to see a medical prescriber first.

These new laws allow friends, family members, or caregivers of people taking opioids to **get naloxone at the pharmacy**. If you prefer, you can still obtain a prescription for naloxone from your physician.
