Rhode Island has been a model in the fight against overdose thanks to your efforts. **But at the same time, overdoses have still gone up.**



Research is better with all of us. So we are trying out a new tool.

But in order to figure out whether it will work, we need to research it. This new research project can hopefully put us one step ahead.



Because this is research, we will use **PROVIDENT** predictions in some towns, and not others.

We all will be receiving some extra tools, resources, and opportunities to collaborate.













What does the PROVIDENT research project mean for me?

As community research partners we are asking for your help.

This means collecting more information about what you are already doing, and gathering more data on your planning process. We also want to hear how you use data and the web tool to inform your decisions.

PROVIDENT is like a weather forecast, but for overdose!



The tool uses sophisticated models to give us these predictions at the **neighborhood level**.

Lots and lots of data:

Temperature, humidity, pressure, wind, clouds, historic information, regional variation

Click **Dashboard** up top to go to the PROVIDENT map. This gives us a view of all of the neighborhoods and towns in Rhode Island







The areas you can highlight and select are called **neighborhoods**. These are smaller parts of each town or city.







You will also see different types of shading on the map that mean different things





A town with light lines through it means that the town doesn't receive any predictions. But you can still click on the neighborhoods to learn more about them!

The names of the locations are the closest location for the data. So just treat these points as general areas where there are more people.
