

What to Know about Fentanyl

Fentanyl is a strong opioid that is often found in our drug supply. It has been found in drugs such as heroin, crack cocaine, powder cocaine, and other substances.

It is often in fake pills sold as Adderall®, oxycodone, Percocet®, and Xanax®. Pills from sources other than a pharmacy should be assumed to have fentanyl in them.

Don't Use Alone

If you use drugs, make sure someone you trust is nearby and can check on you when you're using. In the event of an overdose, they can respond by calling 911, administering naloxone, and supporting breathing.




Have Naloxone Nearby

Naloxone can stop an opioid overdose. Make sure you and your friends carry naloxone. Have it with you or nearby and ready to use in the event of an emergency. You can get naloxone for free from many community organizations, through your health insurance, or at a pharmacy or other retailer.



Use Fentanyl Test Strips

Fentanyl test strips provide an easy-to-use way to see if any drugs have been mixed or cut with fentanyl. When you get your result, you can make a decision about what to do next.



Call 911 and Administer Naloxone If There Is an Overdose

If there appears to be an overdose, call 911 and give naloxone if it is on hand. Emergency personnel can provide more naloxone as well as other types of medical support. The Good Samaritan Law provides certain legal protection, whether you have drugs on you or not.

Get FREE harm reduction supplies and other resources:

These organizations give out free supplies like naloxone, fentanyl test strips, and new drug-use supplies. They can also connect you with wound care, treatment, recovery support, and basic needs like food, housing, and peer-to-peer services.
